<u>Discipleship - Nurture - Accountability = DNA</u>

Looking Back (Accountability)

What was the commandment from the previous week?

Did you obey the command as you had planned to?

What is one specific thing we can do this week to continue obey that commandment?

How has our time and relationship with the Lord been this past week?

Looking Forward (Disciple)

Have each person recite the current command. (if some don't all have it memorized take time to memorize it)

What is the context (who it is spoken to and why is it being spoken to them) of the verse and what is the command contained in the verse?

Discuss how this command challenges our current lifestyle.

Discuss how we can specifically begin to live out this command more regularly in our life.

Looking Inside (Nurture)

How have we been doing in our inner life/private world?

What are we thankful for?

How can we serve or take care of you?

How can we pray for one another this week? (<u>Take time to pray</u> <u>here</u>)

- ~ Jesus is the Builder of the ekklesia & we are the ekklesia, His called out ones
- ~ We live in the Kingdom of God & Jesus is our King
- ~ Laws of His Kingdom
 - Love (agape) God
 - Love (agape) people neighbor, enemies, one another
 - Be & make disciples by keeping His commands
- Me & Jesus every day, abiding in Christ, listening to Him, meditating on the command and story, keeping and obeying the command
- 2. **Me & you** 2-5 disciples meet weekly (DNA)
 - discuss the commands and stories
 - care for one another
 - help one another obey the command

When meditating on the commands and stories, keep these questions in mind:

- What do I learn about God, Jesus, and/or the Holy Spirit?
- What do I learn about man/ people?
- What troubles or bothers me? What does the Holy Spirit reveal to me in light of this?
- How does the command connect to the story?
- What is God saying to me (or what should I obey) & what am I going to do about it?
- Do I have any fears, doubts, or resistance in keeping this command?
- What does this command reveal about the condition of my heart – what do I really believe and what do I really want?
